## Vermont Cheesemakers Festival Tours, Workshops | July 24, 2010

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Vermont Farm Tours, a Burlington, VT-based culinary tour outfit, will offer five cheese tours (\$95 per person) and three cheesemaking workshops (\$50 per person) throughout the state on July 24, the Saturday before the Vermont Cheesemakers festival.

### Workshops

1. Cows Milk Mozzarella & Ricotta at Family Cow Farmstand | 10am-12pm | Hinesburg, VT
2. Goats Milk Chèvre at Trevin Farms Bed & Breakfast | 9:30am-12:30pm | Sudbury, VT
3. Goats Milk Feta at Windy Corners Farm | 9am-12pm | Charlotte, VT

All tours include transportation from Manchester, Middlesex, or Shelburne, VT, a local picnic lunch, a tasting at each farm, a Vermont Farm Tours tote to fill with cheese, and tour notes that provide contact information and a brief description of each producer.

Tours begin at 9 or 10am and conclude at 5 or 6pm. For the central and northern tours, guests are encouraged to dine at Bluebird Tavern in Burlington on Saturday night for a Festival-themed menu.

Vermont Farm Tours is also organizing three cheesemaking workshops taught by the farmers themselves on small farms in Hinesburg, Sudbury, and Charlotte, Vermont. Workshop participants will leave with cheese to share!
